The Spokane Public Facilities District is monitoring the impact of Covid-19 (coronavirus) in and around our community and are in frequent contact with our local, state, and federal partners. Our immediate priority is always the health and safety of our clients, participants, volunteers, staff, guests, and spectators.

We are following the mandate issued this morning (Monday, 3.16.) by Washington State Governor Inslee of statewide closures including entertainment, restaurants (except for take-out, delivery, drive-thru), bars (except for take-out, delivery, drive-thru), and recreational activities beginning Tuesday, March 16 at 12:01 a.m. for a period of two weeks. In addition, the Spokane Public Facilities District is following federal guidelines issued Monday, 3.16.2020 afternoon of avoiding gatherings of more than (10) ten people.

The Spokane Public Facilities District is also currently working with event producers to re-book canceled/postponed shows. Please continue to monitor our websites (spokanearena.com, inbpac.com, spokanecenter.com, spokanepfd.org) and social channels as we will keep you up to date on event schedules.

In order to do our part in keeping employees the community safe, the Spokane Arena Box Office will be closed until March 31, 2020.
