Dear Mr. Twohig:

On May 03, 2013 the Department of Ecology received notice that Spokane city approved your application for an SDP. Your permit is for Spokane Convention Center Completion Project/Addition at 334 W Spokane Falls Blvd, Spokane, WA 99201.

By law, local governments must review all SDPs for compliance with:

- The Shoreline Management Act (Chapter 90.58 RCW)
- Ecology's Substantial Development Permit approval criteria (Chapter 173-27-150 WAC)
- The City of Spokane Local Shoreline Master Program

Local governments, after reviewing SDPs for compliance, are required to submit them to Ecology. Your approved SDP has been received by Ecology.

**What Happens Next?**

Before you begin activities authorized by this permit, the law requires you wait at least 21 days from May 03, 2013, the "date of filing". This waiting period allows anyone (including you) who disagrees with any aspect of this permit, to appeal the decision to the state Shorelines Hearings Board. You must wait for the conclusion of an appeal before you can begin the activities authorized by this permit.

The Shorelines Hearings Board will notify you by letter if they receive an appeal. We recommend you contact the Shorelines Hearings Board before you begin permit activities to ensure no appeal has been received. They can be reached at (360) 664-9160 or <http://www.eho.wa.gov/>

**Other federal, state and local permits may be required in addition to this shoreline permit.**
