Background

The Spokane Convention Center Completion Project is being developed by the Spokane Public Facilities District (SPFD). The Permit applications, Habitat report, Traffic letter, and SEPA checklist were submitted to Tami Palmquist at the City of Spokane on January 10, 2013. Tami will review the submittal for completeness. The SEPA checklist and DNS was issued on January 16, 2013 with comments due by January 30, 2013. Most background information included in the checklist is located on the SPFD's website at www.spokanepfd.org.

Three design build teams have been selected and are preparing a design and project proposal for final selection in April 2013. Once the design build team design is selected, the design will be developed and go through the City's design review process during which final conditions will be developed.

It is the intent of the SPFD to provide the design build teams with information received from the review of the SEPA checklist, Stakeholder meetings, and from review of the project by the City of Spokane. We expect that this information will help the City of Spokane develop conditions of approval that would be applied to the design of the building façade, the site landscape plan, and the riverbank improvement project; and, ultimately, help the SPFD build a better project.

Purpose of Meeting

Those in attendance will discuss the project review process, information received during Community and Stakeholder meetings, input from the SEPA checklist review, and other issues and opportunities to assist the design build teams.
